RESOLVED to approve chemical pond treatments at a cost not to exceed \$7,914.

<u>Annual Meeting</u> – the open meeting was recessed at 8:02 p.m. to hold the Annual Meeting & Election. Failing to reach a quorum the Annual Meeting & Election could not be held and the existing Board members will continue to serve until the next Annual Meeting & Election.
